The Copper Mark



Operations Update Townsite Projects

- Gila Health Resources remodel is ongoing
 - Phase 1 complete with full project forecasted to be done by end of 2024
- Big Tex BBQ and Zuly's opening in Morenci Plaza
- Shade canopy to be added to Community Center Kids Corner play structure
- American Legion restrooms scheduled to be upgraded Q1 2024
- Marathon improvements include four fueling stations and two electric charging stations in Q4 2024

Infrastructure Projects

- Shannon Hill Water Tank upgrades completed, paving to be done in April 2024
- Copper Road area water and power lines upgrade to be completed in April 2024

- Work completed on Aquifer Protection Permit and Point of Compliance wells
- Project started to determine how to protect Yellow Billed Cuckoo habitat while continuing to provide water access to cattle
- Started Ethnographic Study of the Tribes that call the Morenci area ancestral land
