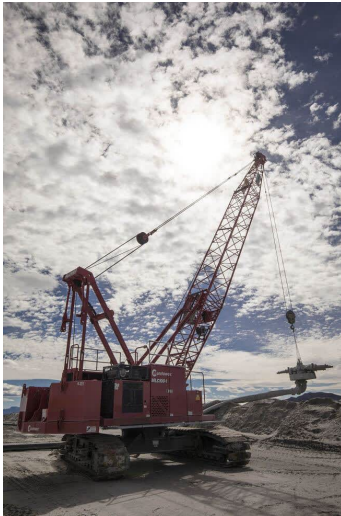

Freeport-McMoRan has achieved the Copper Mark at all 12 of its copper producing sites globally and has achieved the Molybdenum Mark at its two primary molybdenum mines, four copper mines that produce by-product molybdenum and at its molybdenum conversion facilities. Operations Update [Lone Star Phase 2 Leach Pad](#)

Clay from an on-site borrow pit is being placed and compacted, followed by installation of the engineered liner, as construction progresses on the site's newest leach pad.

[Fine Ore Stockpile \(FOS\) Project](#)

FOS will provide 8-12 hours of ore storage capacity – greatly improving the ore supply buffer between the mine and the leach pad and safely stabilizing production during downtime for maintenance activities.

[Safford Pad Run of Mine \(ROM\) Closure Update](#)

Safford's recent placement of ROM material on the original Safford Leach Pad requires an amendment to our Aquifer Protection Permit because our current closure elevation for the facility is 320 feet and the new proposed elevation, with plans to continue ROM stacking on the pad, will be 600 feet.
