- Drilling Program: The formal hydrological/ geotechnical work, which was visible from McGee Ranch Road and Montana Vista is complete. Data analysis and in-field followup are expected through the first half of 2024.

- New well infrastructure expected to be complete Q2 2024 (timeline adjustment from EOY 2023)
