

Operations Update



- Climax is executing its 2024 mine plan while maintaining a strong focus on safety.
- The Monthly Housing Allowance increased from \$450 to \$1,450 for all Colorado site employees (Henderson and Climax).

Environmental Update

- Molybdenum Water Treatment Plant Construction continues and should be completed by Q1 2025.
- The state's molybdenum standard was reviewed at a regulatory hearing scheduled for June 10.
- Current projects include the upgraded fuel facility, salvaging McNulty Gulch Soil, and concurrent reclamation.
- The Environmental team is partnering with the Cottonwood Institute and will host high school students in July and August at Climax.
