Operations Update



- Henderson and Climax continue to increase internal staff numbers and to reduce the number of contractors.
- Climax is targeting a headcount of 510.
- Henderson is targeting a headcount of 418.
- Climax will be transitioning to a 24/7, 4-crew schedule.

- The crusher rebuild project that commenced in Q2 has been completed at Climax.
- The company is satisfied with the use of the Enterprise vehicle carpool program and pleased that the opportunity exists for employees with the onset of winter weather.
- Climax Molybdenum Company is involved in four local housing projects to help address workforce challenges. In addition to the Leadville Bank Building, which was purchased in 2022, Climax Molybdenum has entered into a master lease agreement with Silver King Apartments in Leadville and Muddy Creek Cabins in Kremmling this year. The 4th North Project in Silverthorne

is in development and could help support all three sites: Henderson mine, Henderson mill and Climax mine.

Environmental Update

- Construction of the Henderson mill water treatment plant is anticipated to start in early 2025, with anticipated completion in mid-2027.
 - The water treatment plant will be smaller than the URAD water treatment plant but will have a similar capacity.
 - Henderson has resubmitted the Grand County 1041 permit application in advance of a public hearing in Q1 of 2025.
 - Awaiting final discharge permit from the Water Quality Control Division.
- The Climax water treatment plant construction is on track for Q1 commissioning.
