

Operations Update



Crush and Convey Upgrades

Upgrades at Safford's Crush and Convey division are underway with ongoing improvements or replacements at crusher and agglomeration facilities, as the site continues to incrementally increase ore throughput.

MILESHIGH Project

- Freeport selected by U.S. Department of Energy for award negotiations for \$80 million in federal funding for MILESHIGH Project
- Targets three technologies: Microgrid capabilities, Battery Energy Storage System (BESS), and geothermal clean heat.
- Investment timeline includes four project phases: project planning, project development, integration and construction, ramp-up and operation.
- Community benefits plan:
 - Ongoing engagement and local hiring
 - \$100,000 Freeport match to the Arizona Economic Resource Center to invest in capacity and infrastructure resilience

Environmental Update

Rail Spur Feasibility Assessment

- Freeport and Arizona Eastern Railway evaluating prospect of direct rail spur to the Safford mine, located east of Safford near the San Simon River
- Alternative analysis and conceptual design completed
- · Private lands rights-of-way secured, and Arizona state land easement application submitted
- Preliminary Jurisdictional Delineation application submitted to Army Corps of Engineers for Gila River bridge crossing

- Local Traffic Impact Analysis completed
- · Feasibility Study and engineering in progress

Recent Property Acquisition and Cleanup

- 80-acre parcel (formerly known as Anderson Farms) south of City of Safford firing range at Dry Lake Park
- Historically distressed property which has been used as an illegal dump site
- · Property cleanup efforts are ongoing
